### **QUOTIDIAN REFLECTIONS: ARTWORK BY CAROL ANTHONY**

Carol Anthony's paintings of still lifes, landscapes, and modest interiors are poetic, contemplative images that call our attention to the beauty of the everyday. Anthony grew up in Connecticut with a twin sister, and the girls began drawing at the age of two. Her father was vice president of an advertisement agency and a cartoon contributor to *The New Yorker*, and her mother was a singer. She lost her mother as a teenager, her father while in her twenties, and her sister to breast cancer in 1996 — experiences that have informed much of her work.

McLarry Fine Art (225 Canyon Road, 505-988-1161) opens Enough, an exhibit of Anthony's new works, on Friday, Dec. 18th. The exhibition is shown in conjunction with the release of Carol Anthony: Paintings, Prints, and Constructions 1975-2015, published by Radius Books. The book is the first full-length survey of the artist's career and includes numerous examples of her monotypes, works in oil crayon, and papier-mâché, as well as her writings. The show was co-curated by Anthony and includes ephemera from her home and studio. Anthony signs copies of the new book during the opening reception at 5 p.m. — Michael Abatemarco
